#### **About TMA Fergana**

The Fergana branch of the Tashkent Medical Academy was established on the basis of the Medical Center at the Ferghana State University by Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. 239 of June 3, 1998.

Currently, the branch works with medical schools of the Republic of Uzbekistan, as well as in the specialties of "Medical and pedagogical work", "Medical and preventive case" and "Higher medical care", "General practitioner", "Doctor". "General Hygienist Epidemiologist" and "Highly Educated Nurse".

Clinical departments are located in the Fergana branch of the Tashkent Children's Hospital and the No. 2 Children's Hospital.

During the learning process, a computerized fleet of 100 modern computers is used. The branch has an Information Resource Center. The Information Resource Center and its branches are equipped with computers, printers, scanners and copiers.

The classrooms are equipped with video bikers, computers and projectors, 8 specialized training laboratories, about 60 modern equipment and specialized laboratories.

The Institute has indoor Canteen/Mess Facility One Indoor sports outdoor sports facilities.

#### **Internal Control & Monitoring Department**

#### **About Fergana**

Ferghana, is the capital of Fergana Region in eastern Uzbekistan. Fergana is about 420 km east of Tashkent, about 75 km west of Andijan, and less than 20 km from the Kyrgyzstan border.

While the area has been populated for thousands of years, the modern city was founded in 1876. It was initially named New Margelan, then renamed Skobelev in 1907 after the first Russian military governor of Fergana Valley. In 1924, after the Bolshevik reconquest of the region from basmachi rebels, the name was changed to Fergana, after the province of which it was the center.

The industrial base of Fergana was developed in the 20th century. Industry in the city included textile manufacturing and a nitric fertilizer plant. Some of the industrial development was a result of Evacuation in the Soviet Union during World War II.

Fergana has been a center for oil production in the Fergana Valley since the region's first oil refinery was built near the city in 1908. Since then, more refineries have been added, and Fergana is one of the most important centers of oil refining in Uzbekistan. Natural gas from western Uzbekistan is transported by pipeline to the valley, where it is used to manufacture fertilizer. The Great Fergana Canal, built almost entirely by hand during the 1930s, passes through the northern part of the city and completed in 1939.


